

SCMA Membership Survey Results 2016

The following results are from our recent Membership Survey; distributed by email to 4370 SCMA members on 10 February 2016. The survey received 603 responses, which is a response rate of 14%. The 2016 survey attracted a 26% increase in responses, when compared to our previous nationwide survey in November 2014 (443 responses).

The following results provide an overview of our membership services, how we are rated by our members and the areas we can improve upon. The feedback and results are divided into six sections, including SCMA Membership, Learn with SCMA, SCMA Online, *Childminding* magazine, Early Learning and Childcare, and Prize Draw.

SCMA Membership

Q1. Are you happy with your SCMA membership?

[&]quot;I like the support and education, and belonging to a wider family."

[&]quot;SCMA keep me up-to-date, do a lot behind the scenes to benefit all childminders, fight for us, provide good training and networking, good support and very friendly staff."

[&]quot;I've used it to do a lot of e-Learning courses and use a lot of resources."

[&]quot;Yes, although not sure about active involvement with SCMA in the Highlands."

[&]quot;Yes, however more needs to be done to raise our profile."

[&]quot;I have been with SCMA since I started being a childminder over 30 years ago and you have never let me down when I need information or support."

[&]quot;I was seriously considering not renewing my membership when funding was withdrawn for our local CDO, but reconsidered as she has been kept on - albeit on reduced hours."

[&]quot;Everything you need, advice, paperwork and they all there make my life simpler."

[&]quot;Not been a member for a few years but came back due to the training opportunities."

[&]quot;We don't get courses for free and having to pay £80 for nothing."

[&]quot;Lack of local training on offer."

[&]quot;I don't believe I receive adequate information and updates."

[&]quot;I feel SCMA should hold the Care Inspectorate to task more."

[&]quot;Really not worth the money - £40 for workshops! I have sourced my own with a professional who work in the field."

[&]quot;SCMA don't seem to do much."

[&]quot;It is expensive, but I'm happier with free insurance." [confused with childcare.co.uk?]

[&]quot;It's only for stationary and insurance."

[&]quot;I get more work through childcare.co.uk, they have free e-training and include PLI."

[&]quot;I don't feel the benefit of being a member of SCMA. I understand that the SCMA are working behind the scenes representing childminders, but I don't feel the direct benefit of this."

[&]quot;No courses in our area that are free - why should we pay £40 when others pay nothing and not everyone has ILA?"

[&]quot;I may have to leave childminding, as I feel we are going to get fewer children due to Highland Council not using childminders. If I can't fill space I can't afford to stay in a job I have loved for the last 15 years."

[&]quot;I have no plans to cancel, but I'm only working six hours per week because our local nursery now opens at 8.30 am this has affected me badly. And now, the 600 hours of early learning and childcare makes matters worse. Over the 25 years, I have always been full."

[&]quot;I don't earn enough from childminding, and I'm concerned I haven't made enough money to pay into a pension in 10 years. I have to think about my longer term situation."

[&]quot;I don't enjoy childminding as much as I used to - partly due to the GIRFEC."

[&]quot;I am not keen on computers so don't use the website or Facebook often, and I feel miss out sometimes."
