Personal Plans (sometimes referred to as a Child's Plan) set out the essential information that childcare providers in Scotland are required to hold for each child in their service.

Confused about Personal Plans?

Need help getting through an upcoming inspection?

Our Personal Plan Organiser contains clear easy-to-use guidance to help you get to grips with Personal Plans and ensure each child's Personal Plan is complete and meets the requirements of the Care Inspectorate.

Please refer to the guidance contained within the Personal Plan Organiser when completing the relevant forms. Personal Plans should be updated at least every six months. SCMA Personal Plan Organiser is an all-in-one tool to help you organise your Personal Plans, record information and meet the needs of your childminding service. Developed alongside the Care Inspectorate, our Personal Plan Organiser is a binder that contains forms, records and templates to ensure you comply with the law and the requirements of your registration.



Public Liability Insurance

Childminders are required to hold valid Public Liability Insurance (PLI). SCMA membership automatically includes SCMA Practitioner Insurance, arranged by Morton Michel and underwritten by Covea Insurance PLC, so you can be sure that you, your business, and the children you care for are covered.

It's essential that you hold valid PLI to protect your childminding business against legal costs and compensation payments that may result from injuries or property damage of your minded children.

- ✓ SCMA Practitioner Insurance provides a Public Liability limit of £10,000,000 to cover damages, legal costs and expenses
- Babysitting Cover babysit children in their own family home. Procedures apply
- ✓ Loss or damage to third party property *limit of £10,000,000*
- ✓ Loss or damage to minded children's property *limit of £10,000,000*
- Outings, crèches and other meetings cover for all childminding events, outings and activities.

Got a childminding assistant?

Employer Liability Insurance is essential for services that are registered with a childminding assistant(s), including unpaid and paid employees.

Employer's Liability cover is offered as part of the SCMA Practitioner Insurance included in SCMA membership.


