

Erratum: Correction to Early Learning and Childcare Audit 2025

In the Early Learning and Childcare Audit 2025 an error occurred during writing the section on 'Programme for Scotland's Childminding Future: update' on page 16.

In bullet points three and four the text stated:

- 89 new childminders have completed their registration with the Care Inspectorate (with 86 of these also having now received a £750 start-up grant and established their new childminding businesses around Scotland).
- a further 217 candidates have completed and submitted their applications to become childminders.

The word "further" in bullet point four was used in error as at the time of capturing the snapshot the number of newly registered childminders in bullet point three were included within this number rather than being additive.

This error has been corrected within the published document which now reads:

 217 candidates have completed and submitted their applications to become childminders to the Care Inspectorate; of whom 89 new childminders have completed their registration with the Care Inspectorate (with 86 of these also having now received a £750 start-up grant and established their new childminding businesses around Scotland).
